- Exam Board: CCEA
- Pupils will be formally assessed by two written assessments at AS Level and at A2 level by one written assessment and a 4,000 word research based assignment.
- The research task (coursework) will be undertaken in Year 14 where pupils will need to meet strict deadlines.
- Support from home is necessary- pupils will receive one draft of coursework as per CCEA guidelines. Pupils will also be expected to access the CCEA N&FS microsite to engage in past paper practice questions and mark schemes in their own time.
- AS modules combined equate to 40% of the overall A2 grade
- Pupil progress is tracked using Marked Assessment Tasks
- Pupils will be actively involved in setting their own realistic targets
- Those who score less than their MAG (Minimum Acceptable Grade) will be asked to repeat any internal tests/assessments.
